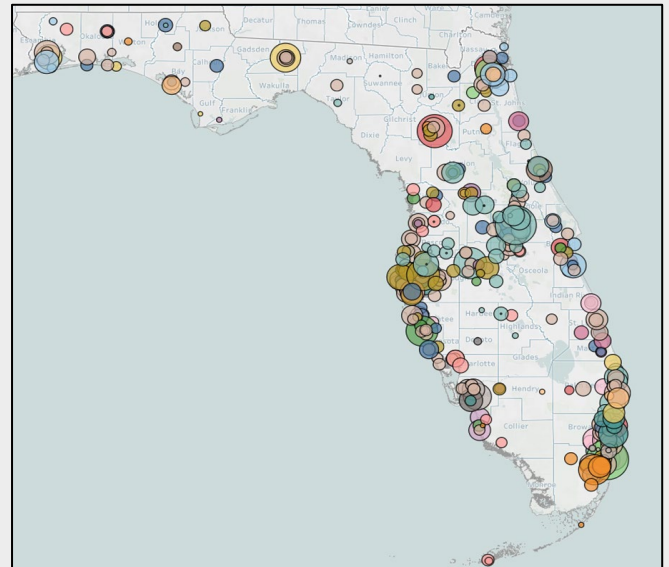
What is ENS[®] ?

The Encounter Notification Service (ENS) provides real-time notice of patient health care encounters from [hospitals and post-acute care facilities](#) across Florida. These facilities send admit-discharge-transfer (ADT) messages in real-time and ENS compares them to patient lists provided by subscribing health care organizations. When a listed patient receives care at a participating facility, subscribers receive an alert containing details about that patient's health encounter.

Why Participate?

- Enable timely post-discharge follow-up reducing readmissions by 30-50%
- Increase transitional care management (TCM) revenue nearly 25%
- Improve clinical quality measure (CQM) reporting
- CMS now requires all hospitals to send encounter data to PCPs
- Qualify for new CMS Primary Care First program
- The first year is **FREE** for Medicaid providers with low annual subscription thereafter
